General Information: The Thalassic Society (Oceanography graduate student organization) is holding its fourth annual Student Symposium. The student symposium is open to the departments of Oceanography, Meteorology, and Geology as well as any other graduate students working on aquatic research in other FSU departments. Date: This year's symposium will be held on November 5 and 6. Oral presentations on Nov 5 and 6 in CSL 1003 and poster session on Nov 6 in Union 312-315 or OSB 3rd floor.

Format: Oral presentations are 12 min with 3 min for questions. Posters can be no larger than 3' X 4'.

Registration: Graduate students wishing to register can email Erin Easton (easton@ocean.fsu.edu or eee04c@fsu.edu) with abstract, times unavailable to present (class times), and preferred presentation type by October 2 at 5 pm. Please email preferred presentation type ASAP, so I can better plan the event. I will respond to your email to confirm receipt of your registration. If more people register than we have time slots or space, a committee will be formed to reduce the number of presentations. The committee will be formed from student representatives in each department. We should have space for ~38 oral presentations and ~45 posters.

Awards: We generally have some awards for oral and poster presentations, which are awarded at the Oceanography Holiday party. With additional departments participating this year, we have yet to decide on awards. I will forward that information at a later date.
